THE DATA WE COLLECT?

We're pleased to comply with the newly enforced General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR), adopted and enforced by the European Parliament in 2018.

The information we collect about you via this method could include the following:

1. Visit details. For example, the time spent on each page.
2. Accessing our site. Whether this is via desktop or mobile.
3. Location data. It's always good to understand how far our reach is.

It's important to remember that not one bit of this information allows us to specifically identify who you are, but only how you interact with us from your computer.

COOKIES

Nope, they're not for eating.

A cookie in this sense is a small text file stored on your computer, tablet or mobile device that allows us to gather specific information to effectively improve our site, and the services we provide to you. In essence, these crumbly little pieces of information are there to inform us to how things are going, and to make a better experience for you.

Every computer is able to decline these tasty bits of data. Web browsers are renowned for their sweet tooth, and have cookies automatically enabled. To disable this function you can simply activate this in your browser settings. However, it's important to remember that by declining cookies, you could be missing out on something great.
